DRFC CODE OF CONDUCT

Responsibilities of Doha RFC to it's Members

1. To manage Doha RFC via an Executive Committee, as outlined in the Constitution.
2. To uphold the Bye Laws of Doha RFC and to deal quickly and efficiently with requests or complaints from members.
3. To communicate with members via the website and newsletter Doha RFC news and event information.
4. To organise training sessions and competitive game play for each playing level.
5. To facilitate the traveling of competitive teams to games and tournaments.
6. To maintain the grounds, equipment and facilities at Doha RFC.

Responsibilities of Members to Doha RFC

1. To abide by the Doha RFC Constitution and Bye Laws.
2. To support DRFC teams in home and away games and tournaments.
3. To refrain from partaking in any kind of abusive behavior (verbal or physical) in or around the grounds of Doha RFC or whilst representing Doha RFC.
4. To be respectful of staff members and club officials at all times.
5. To treat equipment, apparatus and furniture with care.
6. To ensure that Doha RFC's good reputation is maintained by upholding its values and by not bringing the club into disrepute by behaving poorly or breaking the Bye-Laws.

This Code of Conduct is particularly pertinent as we exist within an Islamic country and ultimately abide by Islamic laws and traditions. Failure to abide by this Code of Conduct may result in criminal proceedings against the member(s) involved *and* the members of the Executive Committee; Doha RFC could be shut down over a single incident and it's therefore vital that *all* members act responsibly.
